2019 Flood & the WPC...

- Experienced three of the top ten recorded floods on the Mississippi
- Serves a population of 141,000 people in the Quad City Area
- The WPC serves the Cities of Davenport, Bettendorf, Riverdale and Panorama Park
- 30 employees from Operations, Maintenance, Lab and Pretreatment staff.
- Treated 39 million gallons per day of wastewater
- We manage 36 industrial waste permits.
- Produced 4300 dry tons of Class A biosolids and provide it to our Compost Facility.
- We co-generate our own electricity and sell excess to our partner, Mid-American.
- In March of 2022 we started up a 55 MGD, WEDECO Duron UV disinfection facility.
